Mountain village Monte Bre in Lugano


It is possible to reach this village by car or train.




An open-air museum Small Switzerland

Monte Generoso



Panorama Mountain in Lugano. The mountain is accessible by a comfortable train of Capolago.. After journey through unspoiled natural scenery you reach the 1704-meter-high mountain top. Here you have a magnificent view of the lakes (the lakes of Lugano, Como, Varese and Langensee), the city of Lugano. From Monte Generoso, you can make beautiful walks on a lot of trails with a total length up to 51 km. Along the way, you will enjoy the breathtaking and pleasant views ...

For about € 10, - per person per day, you can make the boat trip on the lake and visit villages as Bellagio, Villa Char Lotto and Varese.







Menaggio


One of the most popular places on the Lake of Como is Menaggio. Besides the central location by connecting to Como, Lugano and the north of Lake Como. The village has a beautiful boulevard and many terraces. The old center of the village is slightly elevated and characterized by small alleys.

From the boulevard also leaves the tour boat to many other tourist resorts around the lake, including Bellagio, Como and Varenna.











Morcote en Vico Morcote





10 km to South of Lugano on the shore of the lake stays this beautiful place that has retained its original appearance. Because of this, it has become a major tourist attraction. Along the lake this place has a long boulevard with many terraces and shops. Enter via a 400-sloping staircase, you can visit the 13th century Madonna del Sasso Church.

Also from here regularly depart boats to Lugano and Porto Ceresio. A few meters upstream is located the magnificent Vico Morcote which is definitely worth a visit. You can do a nice walk through the forest which is very nice for children.

Valle Verzasca: een authentieke bergvallei

The valley is surrounded by the Alps with passes in the neighboring valleys at an altitude of 2000-2500 meters. There is a unique entrance to Gordola, near Locarno. The valley is very narrow and V-shaped. Verzasca is considered the wildest major valley in Ticino - the one where the original beauty and architecture traditional has preserved in the form of old stone houses (rustici). These stone houses are now often rented as holiday homes by their owners or by the organization Verzasca Rustici. Despite the limited offer and the beautiful surroundings of the valley, prices are much lower than in the Ascona-Locarno region. Very special, and a nice combination with your holiday at the edge of the lake. www.lugano-italie-camping.com

Balcony of Italy (Balcone d'Italia)



Situated on the Swiss-Italian border in the Lugano Prealps, the mountain of Sighignola stands 4,311 feet (1,314 meters) above sea level, looming over Lake Lugano below. As far as national border markers go, it is one of the most astounding to behold, and the Italian National Trust has rated it as one of the most beautiful places in Italy.



Cavargna: the little "Tibet" of the Lepontine Alps



Up to a few decades ago, Cavargna was considered to be an impenetrable, wild valley. Nowadays, a smooth asphalt road climbing up from lake Piano leads to three villages dominating the valley: San Bartolomeo (850m), San Nazzaro (980m) and Cavargna which, with an altitude of 1,701 meters, is the highest town in the province of Como.

The crown of the Lepontine Alps that surrounds the whole valley offers many excursions: to Pizzo Gino, Monte Garzirola and the top of the Pianchette (all over 2,000 meters). At the pass San Lucio (1,500m), which links Val Cavargna with Val Colla (Switzerland), visitors can find the homonymous sanctuary dating back to the 14th cent.. Every year, on the 12th of July and on the 16th of August, religious services and a great country festival take place in honor of Saint Lucio, a gentle dairyman venerated by the dalesmen because of his generosity towards the poor and patron of the herdsmen and the cheese makers. In Cavargna you can rediscover the various aspects of everyday life by visiting the Museum of the Valley: in the several rooms you can find information on the religious aspects, the housework, the weaving, the production of bread and pasta, as well as ancient jobs like the Locksmith, the Blacksmith, the Alpine Dweller, the Wood man, the Carpenter and the Smuggler.

Rifugio Menaggio



The Rifugio Menaggio offers some of the most unique and spectacular views of Lake Como. If you are and avid hiker visiting Menaggio and the sky is clear, you should not miss a hike up to this Rifugio. Make it either a day trip or an overnight stay that can combine additional hikes to Monte Grona (1,732 m), the church of St. Amate (1,621 m), or Monte Bregagno (2,107 m). If hiking beyond the rifugio during the winter or spring when there is snow, check with the manager of the rifugio to ensure you are taking the route with the least risk of avalanche danger.

It is not really practical to hike from Menaggio all the way up to the Rifugio. Rather, you should get to the town of Breglia, just beyond Plesio, either by car or bus and begin walking from there. The time of the ascent from Breglia to the rifugio is about 2.5 hrs over an elevation gain of 631 m. If you have a car, you can drive a few minutes beyond Breglia to cut your walking time.

The Rifugio Menaggio offers typical Italian rifugio accommodation and meals. This means sleeping in bunks in a common room with other hikers and a rustic but usually very good quality meal. Food is typical of the mountains in northern Italy: minestrone soup, polenta, cheese, cured meats, and basic wine. An overnight stay can cost between 15 and 50 Euros depending on if you take breakfast, lunch, and dinner. A hot shower is an additional 5 Euro. A litre of wine is 8 Euros.

Unlike many other mountain hikes around Lake Como, the Rifugio Menaggio has fresh and cold spring water running in abundance for you to drink and stay cool.
